Stretch your food dollars and get cash reimbursement for serving healthy meals to your day care kids.

For each child you feed, you could receive:

Reimbursement Rates for Day Care Homes

July 2026 - June 2027	Tier 1	Tier 2
Breakfast	\$1.74	\$0.62
Lunch/Dinner	\$3.31	\$1.99
Snack	\$0.98	\$0.27

Claim up to:

- **2 meals + 1 snack OR**
 - **2 snacks + 1 meal**
- per child, per day**

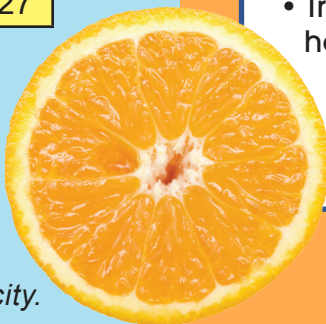
up to your DCFS or IDHS capacity.

You can claim these kids:

- Day care kids **under age 13**

Note: You must qualify by income to claim kids living in your day care home. "Own" kids can only be claimed at meals/snacks with other day care kids.)

- Special needs kids up to **age 18** with an Individualized Education Plan (IEP)



Free Starter Kit
